# THE GOSPEL DEMANDS RADICAL ABANDONMENT - PART III Mark 10:17-31

## A Radical Approach...

Jesus' call to salvation demands total **surrender**.

- Salvation is never a matter of **external** reformation.
- Salvation is always a matter of **internal** transformation.
- Jesus is not merely a respectable **teacher**.
- Jesus is the sovereign **Lord**.

#### A Radical Affection...

Jesus calls us to give sacrificially because He **loves** us.

- He is a Shepherd who **protects** us.
- He is a Father who **delights** in us.
- He is a King who provides for us.

### A Radical Command...

Jesus gives commands, not considerations.

- As followers of Christ, we do not consider **options**.
- As followers of Christ, we **obey**.

#### A Radical Reward...

Jesus does not want to strip us of our pleasure; He wants to satisfy us with His **treasure**.

- Which do we want?
  - ▶ Short-term treasures we can't keep...
    - Or long-term treasures we can't **lose**?
  - ▶ Unpredictable investments...
    - Or inexhaustible **savings**?
- Where is our heart?
  - Our use of money is a sure barometer of our present spiritual condition.
  - Our use of money is a sure indicator of our future eternal destination.

#### A Radical Loss...

Love of possessions will inevitably and ultimately rob us of the  $\underline{iov}$  for which we have been created.

- His eyes were **blind**.
- His face was sad.
- His hands were full.

#### A Radical Shift...

We must understand our use of money and possessions in the context of biblical **history**.

- In the Past (Old Testament)...
  - ▶ Obedience to God led to **acquiring** possessions on earth.
  - God gave possessions to build a <u>place</u> that displayed His glory among the nations.

- In the Present (New Testament and Today)...
  - ▶ Obedience to God leads us to **abandon** possessions on earth.
  - ▶ God gives possessions to build a **people** who take His glory to the nations.
- In the Future...
  - Obedience to God leads us to **accumulate** possessions in heaven.
  - God gives possessions to build a <u>paradise</u> where we will enjoy His glory with the nations.

### A Radical Warning...

We desperately need to realize the **deadly** nature of our possessions.

- The danger we face...
  - ▶ Riches cause us to become self- **confident**.
  - Riches cause us to become self- **sufficient**.
  - ▶ Riches cause us to become self- **centered**.
- The decisions we make...
  - A life of selfish **luxury** that forskes the poor.
  - A life of selfless **love** for the sake of the poor.
- Identify the <u>necessities</u> and luxuries in your life. Be honest.
  Then begin selling and giving away your luxuries for the sake of the lost and the poor.
- Based on your necessities, set a simple <u>cap</u> on your lifestyle and then give away everything else.

#### A Radical Gift...

Salvation is utterly  $\underline{impossible}$  for any and every person apart from the grace of God.

- God **gives** salvation to us.
  - ▶ God does not **sell** us salvation.
  - God does not trade us salvation.
- God **enables** sacrifice in us.
- Each day this week, set aside a specific concentrated time alone and/or with your family and **pray**. Really **pray**. Ask the Holy Spirit to change your desires and show you what He wants you to do. Then begin to do it, in His power, one step at a time.

#### A Radical Freedom...

Jesus frees us from our bondage to ourselves and our **stuff**.

- We are free to **go** wherever He calls.
- We are free to **give** whatever He asks.
- Honestly answer this question: Are you giving <u>less than</u> your ability, <u>according to</u> your ability, or <u>beyond</u> your ability?
- Stop asking how much you can <u>spare</u> and start asking how much it's going to take.

#### A Radical Family...

Jesus unites His people together to enjoy and **encourage** one another as they abandon themselves to Him.

- The **church** no longer seems like an abstract idea.
- **Sacrifice** no longer seems like an adequate term.
- This **world** no longer seems like an acceptable home.
- Decide today that your life and your possessions are His to spend radically for the sake of the lost and the poor around the world.
